01.07.2011	<p>Appellant by Dr. Pramod Kumar Jain, Chairman with Shri Prashant Jain, C.A.</p> <p>Respondent by Dr. Sunil Kumar, OSD, AFRC.</p> <p>The present appeal is directed against the order dated 20.05.2011 of AFRC whereby it was directed that the fee of Rs. 26,550/- per semester or Rs. 53,100/- per annum awarded to the appellant for MBA course, by the AFRC for the academic session 2010-11 shall continue to be applicable for the academic sessions 2011-12 and 2012-13.</p> <p>The appellant is, admittedly running a course leading to MBA/MCA course. However, the appellant's Chairman states that the present appeal relates only to the fee fixed by the AFRC for the course, leading to MBA degree.</p> <p>It appears that the appellant was awarded fee of Rs. 53100/- per annum or Rs. 26550/- per semester for the academic session 2010-11. By the impugned order dated 20.05.11, the AFRC directed that the same fee structure would be applicable for the academic sessions 2011-12 & 2012-13.</p> <p>Aggrieved, the present appeal has been preferred.</p> <p>The appellant has furnished the audited accounts. It was submitted that the appellant is already running into losses and the fee as awarded by the AFRC is inadequate. It was submitted that due consideration for inflationary pressure as well as</p>

additional financial liability on account of increase in salary has not been duly considered by the AFRC, while directing that the same fee for the academic session 2011-12 & 2012-13 shall be realizable by the appellant, as was fixed for the academic session 2011. It was submitted that in view of contentions as above, the fee deserves to be increased upwards.

The contentions as above considered. In view of the contentions regarding inflationary pressure and also requirement of revision of salary, as has been submitted on behalf of appellant, the fee of the appellant deserves to be revised.

In view of the facts as above, it appears just and proper to award fee of Rs. 55000/- per annum or Rs. 27500/- per semester to the appellant. The revised fee as above shall be chargeable by the appellant from the students taking admission in MBA course in the year 2011-12 and 2012-13 in the said institution. The said students shall also be liable to pay caution money and other charges as directed by the AFRC. Other terms and conditions as laid down by the AFRC, shall remain unaltered.
