6. What is the meaning of Autonomous?

Ans: Autonomous is the highest status of a college granted by UGC, New Delhi and affiliating University (e.g. DAVV, Indore). The Affiliating University grants autonomy to the college in reference to designing the curriculum, conducting the examination, declaring the result and submitting the list of eligible candidates for the award of degree to the parent University. The Autonomous colleges do all such activities on behalf of the University. The Degree is provided by the affiliating University (in our case DAVV, Indore). Autonomous status is granted to Institutes having permanent affiliation with university and to those having more than 10 years of reputed standing. Pioneer is proud to boast its standing since 1996 and is proud of permanent affiliation with DAVV.

7. What does NBA Signifies?

Ans: National Board of Accreditation is the Autonomous Body of AICTE and MHRD, New Delhi. It accredits the technical courses such as BE, ME, MBA etc of the colleges on the basis of the quality offered to the Students. 10. What are the advantages to the students getting admission in an autonomous college?

Ans: The autonomous college students have various advantages; few of them are listed below:

- A. The Students study latest curriculum and syllabus which meets out the Industry requirements.

- C. Their examinations are conducted in time so that they are able to complete the degree timely (PG Programs - in two yrs., UG Programs – 3 yrs.)

Ans: Yes, it is compulsory for all the students (UG and PG). There is a common pattern of Uniform for boys and Girls both. Uniform includes Navy Blue Trouser, white shirt, navy blue Blazer with Institute Logo, Tie & Black shoes.

12. What is the meaning of Book Bank?

Ans.: Book Bank is the scheme applicable for MBA, MCA and PGDM students. In this scheme, on deposit of the amount (Prescribed by the Institute time to time) a student will get prescribed number of books for the full semester. He is not interposed to get issued those books again & again.
