
Pioneer Institute of Professional Studies was established in 1996 in the heart of city Indore in 1996 with a vision of “Diligence & Excellence” in the professional

CAMPUS

HOSTEL

LIBRARY

E-LIBRARY

The Institute has a subscription of EBSCO corporate resource net & J-GATE that facilitates an online access to 1200 National and International Journals along with the company profiles, reports, Magazines, newspapers etc. Multiple students and faculty members together access it for their research work, project work and presentations. The Central Library is equipped with advanced systems which students can access to search numerous books, journals and magazines at E-Library. E-Library can be accessed anywhere in the Computer Labs.



HEALTH & MEDICAL FACILITY

The Institute provides medical services to its students and the faculty. As it is having Tie Ups with many reputed hospitals of Indore, the students and faculty members get a reasonable discount. A separate Homeopathy OPD is also available in the premises, where the physician is available from Monday to Saturday during college hours.
