

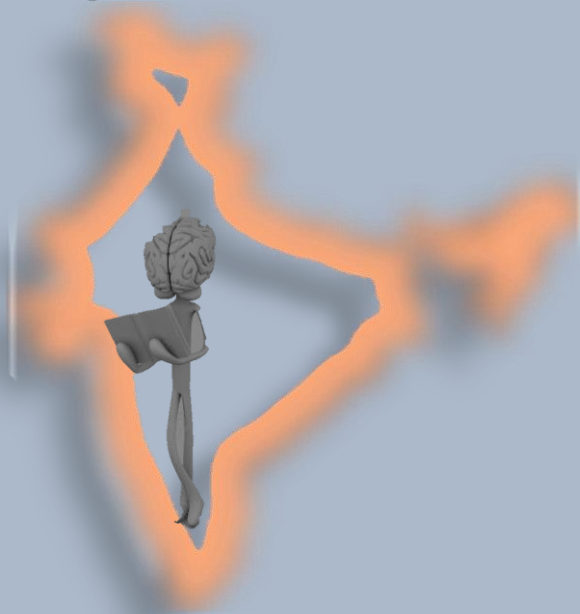

GUIDELINES TO AUTHOR(S)

Guidelines for the Full Paper Submission

Abstracts must include a clear indication of the purpose of research, methodology, expected results, implications, and key references. The author(s) should clearly mention under what track (sub-theme) and category (research paper/conceptual paper/case study) of the conference the abstract is to be included. They should adhere to the following:

Maximum length	6,000 words excluding title/cover page and references
Margins	2.5 cm. or 1 inch
Font	Times New Roman, 12 point
Spacing	1.5
Title page	Title, Author(s), Affiliation(s), Contact Details, Keywords
