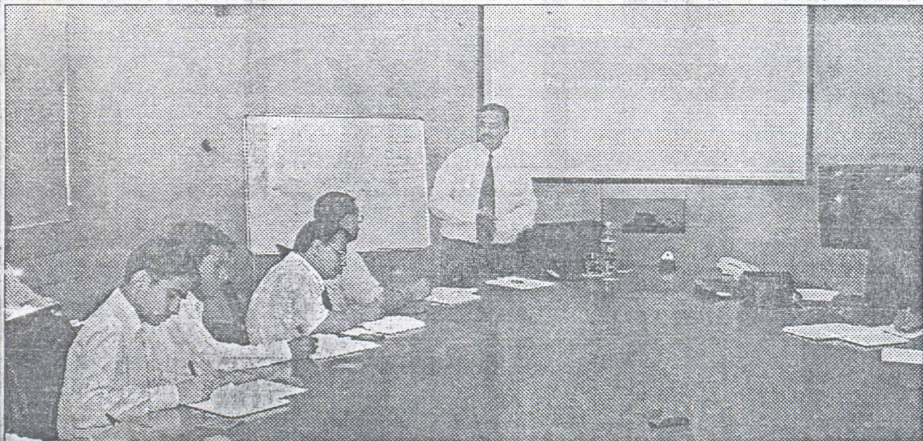


PIPS trains executives
