Item No. 4 Dr. CA Prashant Jain placed the next agenda to discuss the activities for students to be done in the upcoming months (October-November-December 2016), Dr. Mona Tawar in the upcoming months the academic activities shall be going in full swing. Regarding Induction and Orientation Programs, he said the new students meet their roommates, classrooms and through guided tours, campus visit, the orientation provides a safe avenue for new students.

Shri Prakash Chand Jain added that the new students are able to learn about the Remedial and Bridge Courses that they cannot learn during the academic year. Students become familiar with both physical locations and the workings of the college environment during orientation.

Mr. Anil Dhupar was overjoyed to know about the various R & D Plans for the students through the National Conference for the Youth.
