Regarding the R&D, Minor Research Projects for the students has been planned.

Dr. Mona Tawar added the Faculty Improvement Programs is also planned in the forthcoming months.

Mr. Varun Keshari pointed out that NSS Camp will be held in Kayastkhedi, Sanwer. A few Digital Awareness related community development programs are also been planned.

It is also planned that in the forthcoming months there will be many Placement Cell related activities and placements must be run full fledged for both Undergraduate and Post-Graduate Courses.

Dr. P. N. Mishra added that International Conference will do wonders in Learning.
