

## **Standard Guidelines for Research Paper**

- In the Third & Fourth semester, each student will submit a research paper based on their Major research project.
- The research paper will be written by students under the guidance of faculty supervisors. The allocation of guides for Research Paper will be same as MRP. The research paper should be based on MRP. It may be of any of the following nature:
  - Conceptual- Discussing about issues, concept/ theories related to MRP.
  - Literature Review Paper- A student can carry out Literature Review of around 20 papers based on MRP topic & can write around 15 to 20 lines about each paper & can discuss the objectives, methodology used, result obtained by the researcher.
  - Pilot Study based Paper- Students can write paper based on a small sample size by applying some basic or advanced statistical tools.
- The following points keep in mind while writing a research paper.
  - It should be in proper format which is provided by R & D cell uploaded on website.
  - Paper size should be A4.
  - Font Type should be Times New Roman.
  - Font size should be for Text 12, for Headings 14 & Bold and for Subheadings 12 & Bold.
  - Page Margins should be 1” for Top, Bottom, and Left & Right.
  - Line Spacing should be single.
  - Submission of paper should be in spring file only with soft copy in CD attached with file.
